

In our daily routine, we prioritize variety and exploration. Each day brings new projects and opportunities for our students to try out different techniques and products. We kickstart the day by having them warm up their hands through activities like braiding, styling, or working with extensions on mannequins. We then engage in discussions about current trends and analyze looks that I have discovered.

While still in the classroom under Hans', Caitlyn's, or Heather's supervision, students are involved in exciting projects such as test runs, mood boards, and photoshoots. To enhance their understanding of the industry, we incorporate historical research on influential stylists from various time periods. Understanding the origins and evolution of trends is valuable knowledge. Caitlyn takes the lead in teaching color theory and applications, leveraging her extensive expertise.
